## College Visit Questionnaire

Use this worksheet to consider and record your observations for each college you visit. Make sure to take notes and photos, because after you visit a few schools, they will all blend together.

1. Where is the location of campus in relation to your home?
2. Is there access to mass transit/carpooling opportunities?
3. Is the campus setting urban, suburban, or rural?
4. What is the approximate size of the campus in area or acres?
5. What is the total student population—undergraduate and graduate?
6. Do you notice a feeling of community and interconnectedness on and around the campus?

7. Do you notice a feeling of belonging among the student body?
  
8. What is the quantity and comprehensiveness of libraries, books, and research facilities, including hours of operation?
  
9. What is the availability and quality of computer/technology equipment and facilities, including hours of operation?
  
10. What are the choices and quality (clean/spacious/updated) of dorm rooms and residence halls for freshmen? Upperclassmen?
  
11. What are the locations and options for dining halls, including food types and hours of operation?
  
12. Are there alternate dining facilities, using meal plans/points, surrounding campus?
  
13. Notice the prevalence of Blue Light Emergency Phones and campus police or security. Do you have accurate knowledge of campus safety and crime statistics?

14. Which campus security services are available, including shuttles and buddy/escort services?
  
15. Do you have knowledge of the surrounding community, town, or city, including safety concerns and local attractions?
  
16. Do you find the campus to be visually appealing with regard to layout and architecture?
  
17. What is the quality and availability of a fitness center, gym, athletic facilities, and a stadium?
  
18. Are professors accessible and approachable with posted office hours and locations?
  
19. What are the largest classes by number of students? Which classes are offered in this large, lecture hall format?
  
20. What is the process for course scheduling/registration each semester?

21. What is the quality and quantity of program-specific facilities, such as labs, studios, and theaters?
  
22. Which academic support services are offered to students?
  
23. Which health services/healthcare/emergency hotline/support services are offered to students?
  
24. Does it feel like home? Can you see yourself walking around campus? Living there?
